Northern Ontario Joint Apprenticeship Council (NOJAC)

NOJAC independently is responsible for the recruitment and administration of Electrical Apprentices (Construction and Maintenance) for the Electrical Contractors Association Northern Ontario and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 1687 for northeastern Ontario (area covered by Sudbury, Sault Ste Marie, Timmins and North Bay).

Applying to NOJAC

The following documents make up an application package. Only complete packages will be reviewed by NOJAC for eligibility.

Each complete application package must contain:

- Completed NOJAC Application Form (pages 4, 5 and 6)
- Photocopies of High School Transcript* and Diploma, or equivalent
- Photocopies of Post Secondary Transcript and Diploma if applicable
- Current Resume
- Photocopy of existing Contract of Apprenticeship / Training Agreement if applicable
- Three References, including name, position and contact information
- Any additional information applicable to this application

Original transcripts and/or diplomas will not be returned.

* Educational Requirements

Applicants must submit a photocopy of their high school transcript to confirm they have completed the following:

- Grade 12 English or French
- Grade 12 Mathematics
- Grade 11 or 12 Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other) <u>and/or</u> Trade Course(s)
- Graduated from High School

NOJAC's minimum educational requirements for application exceed the current minimum Ontario requirement dictated by legislation.

Information received within an application package, will remain confidential, and only used by NOJAC in the Application Review Process.

NOJAC replies to complete application packages by email. Applicants are responsible for notifying NOJAC of any changes to their contact information (i.e. email address, mailing address, telephone number, etc.). NOJAC is not responsible for documents sent to incorrect contact information on file.

Deadline for submission: <u>November 30, 5:00 pm</u>.



NOJAC General Knowledge Test

Applicants that submit complete application packages, received by the deadline of November 30, 5:00 pm, that meet or exceed NOJAC's educational requirements* will be emailed a Letter of Invitation, to write the **NOJAC General Knowledge Test** (Test). The results of the Test determine those applicants that proceed in the application process.

Only invited applicants, who have provided NOJAC with written confirmation of their attendance no later than December 31, 5:00 pm, will be allowed into the test area to write that year's Test.

NOTES Written confirmation to confirm attendance received after December 31 will not be accepted, the applicant will be notified as such, and the applicant will not be allowed to write that year's Test.

After applicants have been selected by NOJAC all applications received for that year, will be destroyed.

Applicants must provide NOJAC with a new complete application package every time they apply.

For those applicants reapplying, Test results from previous year(s) are NOT retained and do not influence current Test results or standings.

NOJAC strongly recommends that applicants contact NOJAC to confirm that any documents sent to NOJAC have been received.
